President's Message...

So, what purpose does the BHS Foundation serve? This organization exists to pursue the school's gaps and fulfill its needs. As we embark upon the new school year, I would like to ask for your consideration of giving to BHS. Over the coming weeks, you will learn more about our annual Phone-a-thon. I encourage you to support this fundraiser with monetary donations. However, I also want to encourage you to make contributions throughout the year to assist with enhancements and help our school remain on the leading edge. Former Girls State Participant Reflects on Experience

Whenever I am asked about Girls State, I find it very difficult to explain. As a delegate after my junior year of high school and a Junior Counselor both after my senior year of high school and, soon, after my freshman year of college, it seems even time and more experience at Girls State cannot help me define exactly what it is and what it truly means to me. It is a "mock government" for a week, it is true; but it is also a place where girls from entirely different backgrounds academically and socially come together to form something that is astronomically greater than any of its individual parts — a place where elections are won and lost, where walls we often build around ourselves are torn down in order to allow someone to change us for the better.

During my delegate year, a former delegate and counselor named Amy Piper gave the opening speech. Her speech was honestly one of the most riveting I have ever heard and she said one thing that I will never forget: "Surround yourselves with those who are smarter than you, funnier than you, and kinder than you, so that you may aspire to be like them." I think that describes Girls State the best — it is more than an imaginary government; it is, in fact, a state of mind that still calls me, and so many other young women, to be the person that we all know we have the potential, the determination, and the strength to become.





2007 BHS Foundation Scholarship Recipients


